Dear Resident/Landowner:

Colonial Pipeline Company owns and operates one or more refined petroleum products pipelines on or near your property. The pipeline system is maintained within a right-of-way (ROW) corridor which Colonial obtained by easement from the landowner when the pipeline was installed.

Colonial is committed to operating the pipeline safely and maintaining the ROW corridor is an important part of our comprehensive safety program. Maintaining the ROW corridor requires periodic side-trimming and reclamation to clear the way for inspection of the pipeline ROW from the air and the ground. These routine inspections are a powerful tool in preventing third party damage, which statistics show is the leading cause of accidents involving underground pipelines. Also trimming trees and removing other obstructions from the ROW ensures access to the pipelines for physical inspection, repair, and maintenance of the pipeline.

Another very important consideration in addition to those above is that tree roots have the potential to damage pipeline protective coatings. These coatings prevent corrosion of the steel pipe. As tree roots make contact with the pipe and damage the coating, moisture can make contact with the pipeline and create corrosion.

A side-trimming crew will be working in your area over the course of the next several weeks and will strive to accomplish the work with as little disruption as possible. It may be that there are no obstructions on your property. If so, no work will be required. In any event, Colonial will attempt to contact you personally prior to working on your property and will work with the community during these ROW maintenance activities. Colonial will also contact local officials as appropriate. The On-Site Inspector for this work is Sean Handley, he will be working ahead of the crew and will attempt to make contact with all effected residents and landowners prior to work start. 
