



RIGHT OF WAY (ROW) LANDSCAPING STANDARD

The pipeline right of way you share with Colonial can be used for many activities, but care must be taken when planting or digging on or near the pipeline ROW. Please adhere to the following requirements:

- **Prior to any digging activities, landowners/residents must CALL 811 to have underground utility lines located and marked.**

A call to 811 is required whenever your plans involve any of the following:

- Changing the grade of your property
- Planting shrubs
- Installing a fence or mailbox
- Installing an irrigation system
- Any type of construction project, such as an addition or deck



Know what's below.
Call before you dig.

The following are prohibited on the pipeline ROW:

- Installing permanent structures, such as storage buildings
 - Impounding water on the right of way (damming streams, building a pond or installing a pool)
- **Flower or vegetable gardens may be planted on the ROW** because shallow planting does not disturb the pipeline and the space is open and gets plenty of sunlight.
 - DO NOT dig or till more than 18 inches below the surface.
 - Be careful not to add or remove soil such that the dirt cover over the pipeline is **significantly** altered.
 - **NO trees or shrubs whose mature height exceeds four (4) feet may be planted on the right of way.**
 - Trees or shrubs exceeding four feet in height obstruct the view of aerial patrols of the pipeline right of way. Federal law requires that the pipeline right of way must be maintained clear of obstructions.
 - The roots from trees or shrubs that exceed 4 feet in height can damage the protective coatings that are applied to the outside of the pipeline to inhibit corrosion. This damage can weaken the pipe, causing a potential leak.
 - **DO NOT install landscaping to obscure pipeline markers from view.**
 - Federal law prohibits the removal, obstruction or defacing of any pipeline marker.
